

# OUTDOOR SCHOOL - CABIN INFORMATION

We have two “villages” each consisting of three cabins, with maximum occupancy numbers detailed in the table below. All cabins have electricity, heat, bathrooms and showers.

Girls Village is located furthest from the dining hall and is accessible by a gravel service road. These upper cabins are quieter and require students to walk 1/5 mile from the dining hall. There is a small parking area for 3-4 vehicles by Hemlock Lodge. Unless otherwise requested, we will usually place **females** in the upper cabins

Boys Village are three lower cabins (by the play-courts). These are typically is used for **males (they have urinals)**. Our beds are bolted to the floor, and top bunks are bolted to bottom bunks. Our bunk beds cannot be “split” or moved. We CANNOT exceed the maximum occupancy limit.

**CABIN GROUPS - each cabin has a LEGAL MAXIMUM OCCUPANCY LIMIT.**

**This OCCUPANCY NUMBER IS FOR THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PEOPLE. Please remember to include adults into your cabin assignment numbers. BUNK BED means double bunk with an upper and lower bed. Cot means SINGLE BED.**
